MUSIC·CENTER

PRIOR TO THE PERFORMANCE DAY:

Space:

- 20' x 16' minimum.
- Portable stages must be sturdy and securely lashed.
- Electricity must be turned on in the performance room before artists arrive, so they can set up.

Dressing Area:

- One private, secured dressing room close to the stage will be needed.

Surface:

- Freshly mopped (not waxed)
- Irregularities covered with tape
- Extraneous clutter removed.

Equipment:

- Electrical outlet(s)
- One 8-15' extension cord (two, if available)
- Bottled waters, or drinking water and cups should be provided for 4 people.

ON PERFORMANCE DAY:

Arrival:

- 90 minutes prior to the scheduled start time to prepare and set up.
- Please have electricity turned on before arrival.

Parking:

- Three Spaces.

Assistance:

- Please have a school representative ready to welcome the performers and to stay and help as needed.

Start Time:

- Please prepare to start the program on time.
- Students should be in the venue, seated and ready to begin at the listed times.
